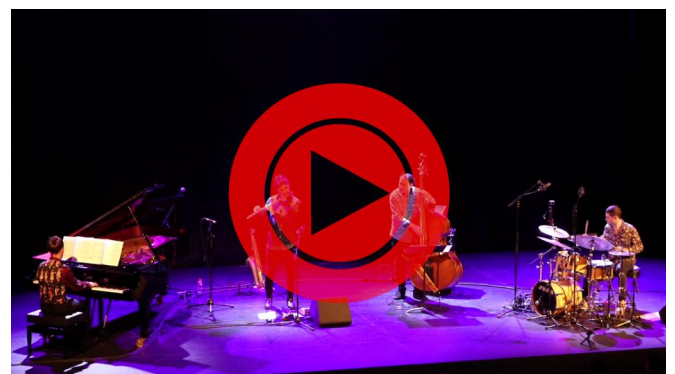
Now he returns full of strength with *Pindio II*, a new album with Manel Fortià, Marco Mezquida and Genís Bagès, a record in which he presents genuine music, cerebral, and visceral simultaneously, music that draws from jazz what it needs to express a way of being in the world: uncompromising, thorough, and straightforward. All complemented by a robust and diverse ensemble that leaves its stamp of quality on every piece.

They have performed *Pindio II* at some of the most important festivals, such as the Südtirol Jazz Festival, Madrid Jazz Festival, Lugo Jazz Festival.
