

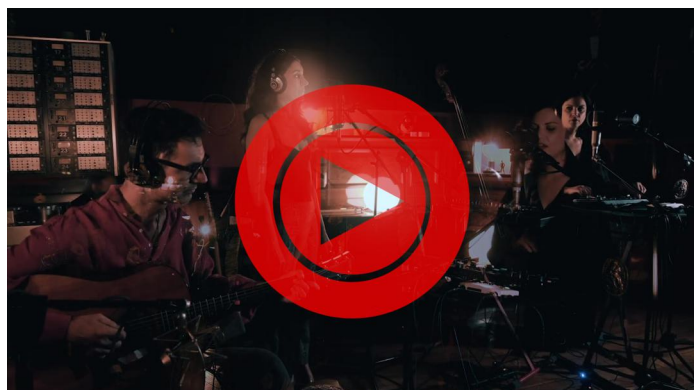


# RA DI SPINA

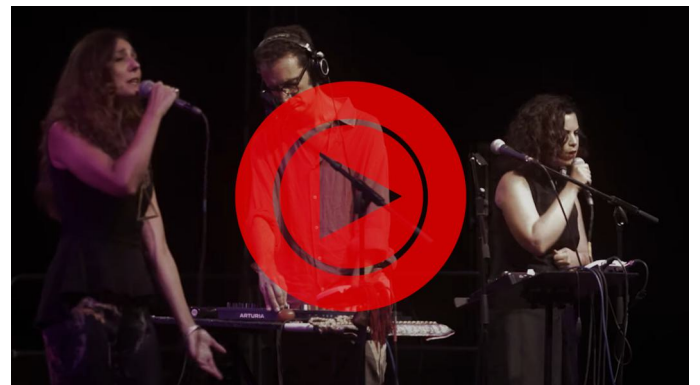
Ethnic roots, deeply related to the heart of popular south Italian folk music, mixed with contemporary electronic sounds of loopstation and synth. Above all, voices, voices, voices. Ra di spina is a vocal-centred project founded by Laura Cuomo, vocalist and researcher.

A timeless music is born, joining voices and electronic sounds, where archaic and modern influences collide.

The ancient and modern voices of southern singer-songwriters, preserved in studio and live recordings, serve as auditory references that bear witness to the living memory of tradition. These voices are a cornerstone of Ra di Spina's music, elevating it through a new concept of vocality, characterized by rough yet enveloping sounds, piercing tones, and intimate vocalizations that evoke a reimagined Gregorian chant.
